- 1 ONE INCH BINDER with pockets for agenda (NO zippered binders)
- 5 SHEET PROTECTORS (In binder)
- 1 pack 5 dividers
- 6 Composition Notebooks (Black Marble 100 sheets wide ruled) 1. Reading 2. Writing 3. Centers 4. Math 5. Science 6. Social Studies
- 6 PLASTIC DUOTANG FOLDERS WITH POCKETS Yellow for Spanish/Blue/Red/Orange/Green/Purple
- 2 ZIPPERED SUPPLY PENCIL CASES NO BOXES (one to keep in each class)
- 10 sharpened #2 Pencils NO MECHANICAL PENCILS
- 2 white erasers (1x2 inches)
- 1 pack sheet lined wide ruled paper
- 2 reams white printer paper (one for each teacher)
- 4 red pens
- 2 highlighters
- 2 child scissors
- 2 large glue sticks (NO LIQUID GLUE)
- 2 boxes of 24 colored pencils
- 2 Hand Pencil Sharpeners
- 2 black SHARPIES
- 1 6 inch ruler (for Reading)

## \*\*\*PLEASE LABEL ALL SUPPLIES

- \*\*Each zipper case is to be filled with: 1 box colored pencils, 1 hand sharpener, 1 large glue stick, 1 pair of scissors, 1 highlighter, 1 dry erase marker, 1 black sharpie, 5 sharpened pencils, 2 red pens and a sock. (and for Reading pencil pouch a 6 inch ruler). All of these items are found on the above list and they are to be divided into both zipper cases to be kept in each class at school NOT to be taken home.
  - \*\*\*EACH set of Ear Buds is to be placed in its own Zip-Lock bag and labled. Each set is to be kept in each separate classroom.
    - \*\*\*\*NO pens, markers, supply boxes, headphones or mechanical pencils
  - \*\*\*\*\*It is suggested that students NOT bring rolling backpacks this year due to lack of storage and safety going up and down the stairs.
